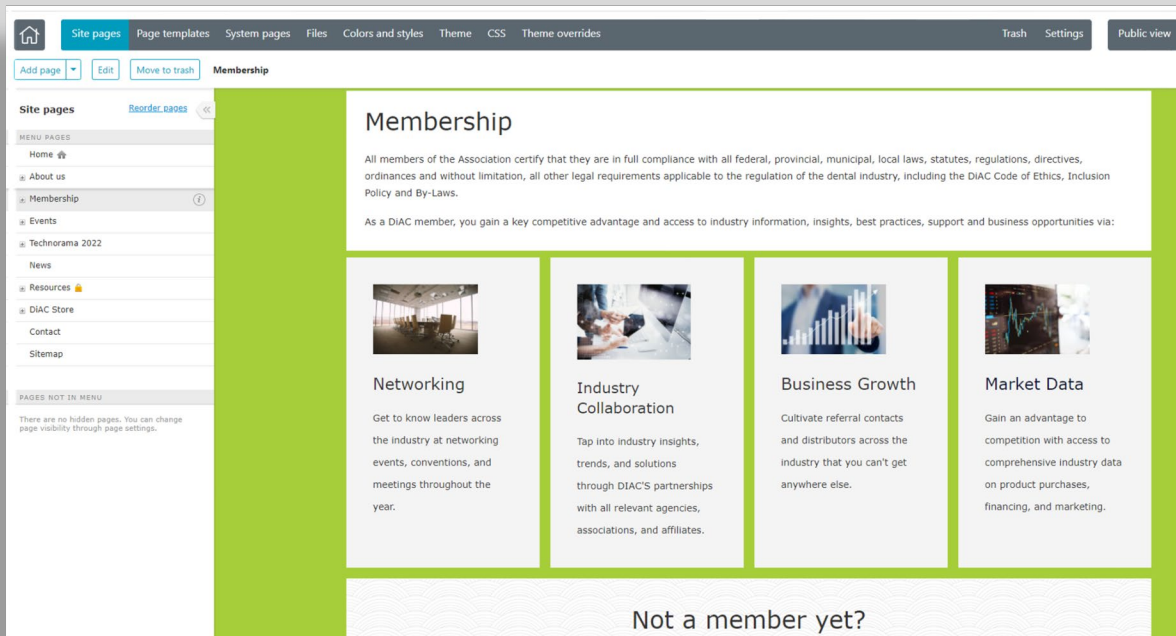

## Canada Closely Monitoring Supply Chain Issues



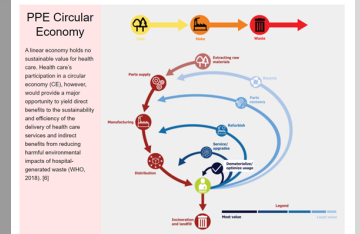
Oct 14, 2020 (Global News) - As the world continues to struggle with a COVID-19 supply chain crunch that has impacted everything from appliance parts to car tires and semiconductors, Deputy Prime Minister Chrystia Freeland acknowledged the ongoing difficulties.

"We are definitely mindful of the supply chain issues in the Canadian economy. We are monitoring the supply chain and Canadian ports very, very closely," she told journalists at a Washington, D.C. news conference recently.

The International Monetary Fund warned earlier in the week that supply chain disruptions will likely mean "more difficult near-term prospects" for advanced

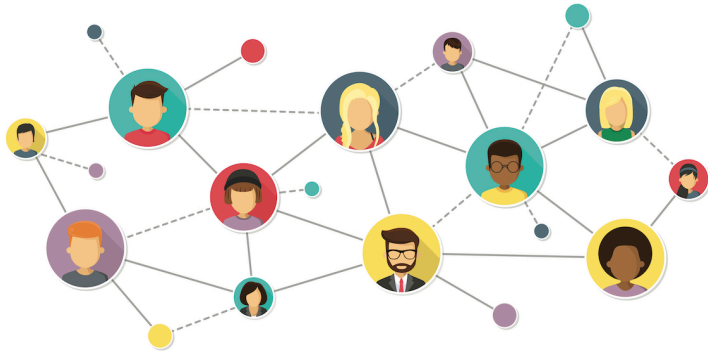
## Medical Single-Use Plastics:
